



Dear Parents,

On **Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> April**, we will be holding our Easter Eggstravaganza and 'Cake and Bake' during the school day. There will be a free Easter egg hunt with a little something for all the children, a 'name the bunny' competition and a treasure hunt game as well as the popular cake sale. As always we're aiming to make the day lots of fun for the children.

We would like to invite all children to bring in some colourful and/or fun fairy cakes on the day, homemade or shop bought. If cakes could be brought in in a suitable container that does **not** need to be returned this would be hugely helpful. We would also welcome donations of larger cakes that will be sold for an appropriate amount at the end of the day. Any containers that need to be returned must be clearly labeled with the child's name and class and will be available for collection from the office on Thursday 7th April. **Please ensure cakes do not contain nuts or fresh cream.** If your children have special dietary requirements then we **can** make arrangements to accommodate them so please let us know before the day by emailing [chairfosvps@gmail.com](mailto:chairfosvps@gmail.com).

On the day of the event, cakes are to be taken to classrooms where they will be collected by adult helpers and the children will be able to buy cakes in the afternoon in class groups. If you are happy for your child to take part, please send them with some change in a named purse / envelope. We will restrict the number of cakes that each child can purchase on the day so that there are plenty for everyone. (Typically the limit is 5 cakes per child). At the end of the day we will sell any remaining cakes in the playground or in the hall, depending on the weather.

Prices (to give you an idea of how much to send your child with);

- Cakes will typically be 20p
- Name the Easter Bunny competition 50p
- Treasure Hunt game 50p

The Easter egg hunt is free and will include smaller chocolate eggs as prizes for all children as well as a larger chocolate egg prize for the winner in each class.

As you'd expect we really need volunteers for this event to run. **RECEPTION AND YEAR 1 PARENTS:** Choosing what to buy and sorting out their change can be confusing for the children in the lower year groups. To make it easier for them, and allow every child to have the opportunity to do everything, **we ask that your child comes in with no more than £2 plus their cake donations.** The teacher will collect the money in the morning as the children come into class. The children will then be allowed to choose a maximum of 5 cakes and to enter both competitions.
