Coronavirus Update

As you are all aware the number of confirmed cases in the this county is steadily rising however the latest information and guidance from Public Health England and Government advice **is we continue to operate as usual**. As a school we are taking extra precautions, these are:

- Washing hands with soap/anti-bacterial liquid regularly.
- Educating the children on how to wash hands....humming 'happy birthday x2 😊'
- Educating the children on 'catch it, bin it, kill it' if they blow their noses.
- We are now wiping door handles throughout the day.
- Keeping as many doors open to prevent touching handles/door plates.
- Insisting that EVERY child washing hands before they eat lunch.
- Preparing home learning online resources for anyone who needs to self isolate.
- Minimising whole school assemblies

If we hear any 'new' information we will inform you as soon as possible.

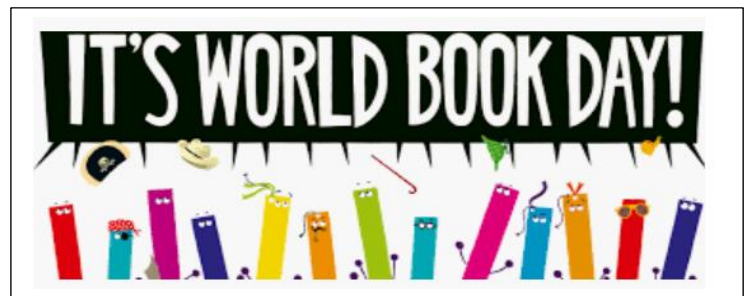
