1. Staggered Drop-off and Pick-Up:

- a. All staff will be wearing masks at drop-off and pick-up
- b. All staff will be wearing masks in corridors and communal areas
- c. All parents are strongly encouraged to wear masks at drop-off and pick-up
- d. All parents WILL need to wear a face mask for face to face parents' evenings

3. No Face to Face Assemblies

- a. For at least two weeks we will not be holding face to face assemblies – these will be done via zoom again
