R.E. Christmas Performances & Concerts

We are all crossing our fingers that we will be able to run our Christmas Performances and Concerts this year. Traditionally we have held a Reception, Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 Concert, however, given that the children have missed opportunities to perform on stage and also to take into account a review of all the performance we have decided to run:

- **Reception and Year 1 Performance – ‘A Miracle in Town’**
 - This will be in school, on the stage with lights and will take the form of a traditional Nativity Play.
 - There will be two performances, **Wednesday 8th December at 2pm & Thursday 9th December at 9.30am.**
 - The plan at the moment is to have parents in to watch; further details around this will be communicated in the next couple of weeks.
- **Year 2 and Year 3 Performance – ‘Lights, Camel, Action!’**
 - This will be in school, on the stage with lights and will take the form of a Christmas Play.
 - There will be two performances, **Friday 10th December at 2pm & Monday 13th December at 6:00pm [children will need to be in school for 5:30pm].**
 - The plan at the moment is to have parents in to watch, further details around this will be communicated in the next couple of weeks.
- **Years 4, 5 & 6 Christmas Concert**
 - This will be at All Saints’ Church on **Wednesday 15th December.**
 - Children will be transported from school to the church
 - There will be **one** performance in the church starting at **4pm**
 - There will be year group singing, readings, instrumentalists performing
 - Children will need to be collected from All Saints’ Church around **5:30pm**
 - The plan at the moment is to have parents in to watch, further details around this will be communicated in the next couple of weeks.

As outlined above, details of how many tickets we can allocate will be sent out over the next few weeks. Let’s all hope that we can have as ‘normalish’ Christmas.
