- Continue to practice your word lists and read your school books.
- Share books from home, discussing events.
- Practice writing by sounding out words phonetically. Write through play e.g shopping lists, letters to people, label drawings, simple sentences.
- Play board games such as snakes and ladders where the children need to count on. Bingo, dominoes etc
- Practical activities such as following a recipe for baking, weighing ingredients etc. Playing shops, cafes etc
- Practice counting objects e.g pennies, buttons.
- Watch 'Numberblocks' episodes.
- Drawing, cutting, threading, painting etc
