RE: CORONAVIRUS – ADDITIONAL SCHOOL ACTION

As announced by the Prime Minister, there will **NOT** be a blanket closure of schools at the moment.

However, some very clear advice has been issued:

• If your child shows symptoms of Coronavirus (continuous cough, new cough or high temperature the very latest advice is now 37.8 degrees or higher) your child(ren) is(are) to stay at home for **SEVEN** days. If in doubt, please call 111 for clarification.

Advice and Guidance from School

- We are working through a staged and sensible risk assessment. Further to the delaying techniques already mentioned in last week's Headlines, additional measures to delay the spread will be enforced with immediate effect (Tuesday 17th March 2020).
- We are taking the extra delaying measure by asking that all siblings self-isolate should there be symptoms in their household.
