Re: Preparing for further re-opening, Year 5 and Year 4 Groups A & B

Dear Parents,

Before you jump to the pages with your child's days (Mon + Tues *or* Thurs + Fri), it is really important to read all the information about how the Groups 'A' and 'B' have been made up.

How have the groups 'A' & 'B' been decided?

Since the further re-opening letter was issued on Friday your child's teacher has been working hard to sort their class into two groups. As said previously, your child has been placed in either Group A or B based on:

1. Siblings (unless the parents have specifically requested otherwise, we have kept your children on the same two days)

2. Friendships we should not forget that, for ½ year, your class teacher has taught your child in school and their friendship circles have been carefully considered.

You will see from your classes list that we have included all the children in the class. We are fully aware that some children will not be taking their place in either group A or B because of the reasons below,

- You or your family are shielding.
- You need to continue to take a place in the Key Worker Group.
- Your child will be, or is attending school but is working in the Woodland Classroom Group.
- You have other personal reasons why your child will not be attending.

What will Home-Learning look like from the 22nd June for Year 4 and Year 5

For Year 4 and Year 5 teachers will prepare **one blog** entry per week. This will direct you to a range of some good quality learning resources. The resources will be appropriate for your child's age. We do expect home learning to continue over the three days of the week that your child is not in school.

We have reviewed these resources ourselves. We feel that they are the best way to provide some purposeful learning for children in Year 4 and Year 5 to complete at home, whilst their teachers are busy teaching and caring for the half of their class in school.
