Re: Preparing for Wave 3 of re-opening, Year 2 and Year 3 Groups A & B from 6th July

Dear Parents,

I am pleased to say that the re-opening for Years 4 and 5 has gone very smoothly so we are now in the position to invite Years 2 and 3 back for the final two weeks.

One of reasons this has worked so smoothly is the 'drop-off' and 'pick-up' arrangements. The Government guidance remains that schools should encourage social distance and avoid large gatherings. **If you do not have any siblings, then it is REALLY important that you only arrive at your year groups allotted times.**

My child is part of the Key Worker Group; can they move into their returning classes?

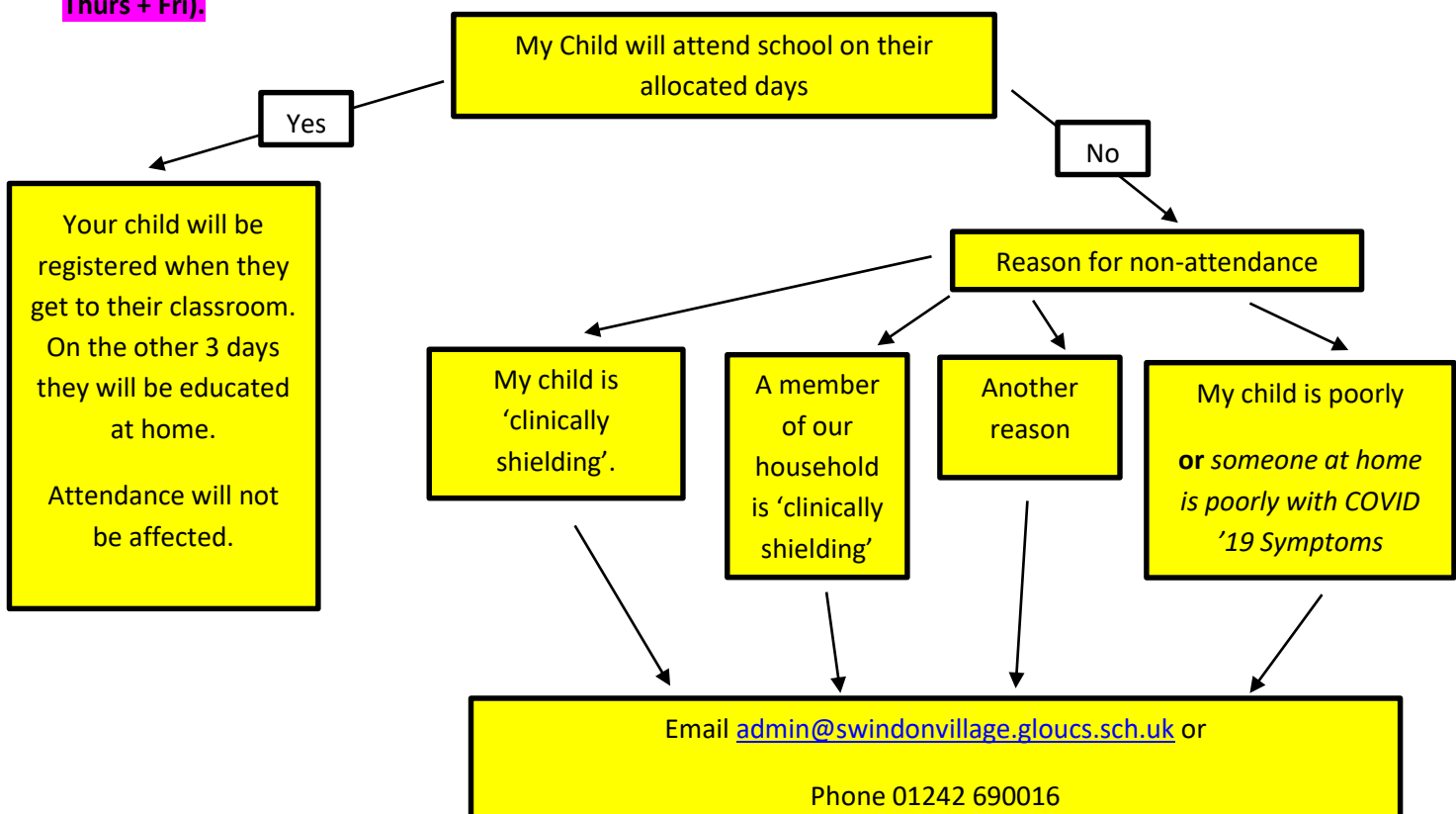
School Dinners – how does this work?
