We will be exploring maps in geography and learning how to ride a bike.

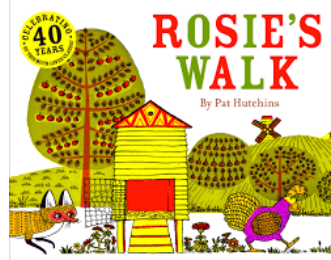
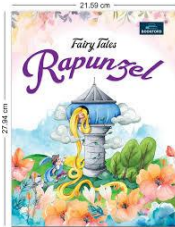
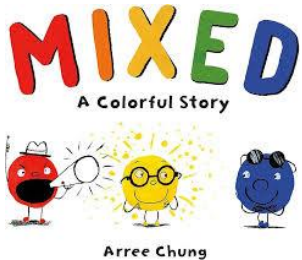
Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be looking at the work of Romero Britto

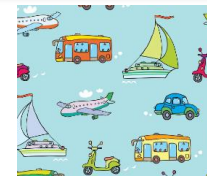


We will make our own fish using paint on the Ipads..
