High quality texts chosen by English KAT and class teachers.

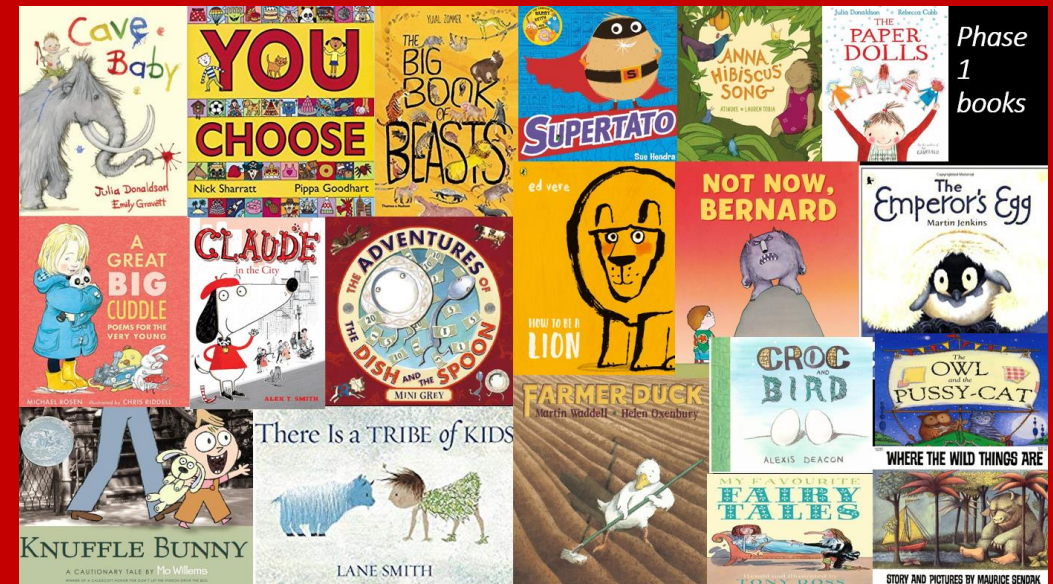
A mixture of poetry, non fiction, classic and contemporary.
