# Ready Steady Read

A 10 book challenge for each year group (a 70 book challenge across SVPS seven year journey).

High quality texts chosen by English KAT and class teachers.

A mixture of poetry, non fiction, classic and contemporary.

Books can read by adults to the children or individually by the children.

Children complete a review after reading or having heard the book.

Children receive a golden ticket for completing which goes into a termly prize draw.

Children who complete all 10 reviews will go into a MEGADRAW at the end of the academic year.
