English


We will be learning to:

Year Two Spring Term Two Overview

This term much of our learning will be about Animals, including humans: Life cycles and health. Our children will be learning facts about healthy living. In Geography we will be exploring our wonderful world

Mathematics

Our units will cover:

- Reading scales
- measurement, length and mass
- Fractions – recognising fractions, finding fractions of shapes, number and groups of objects



We will also be continuing to revise key facts such as the 2, 5, and 10 times tables.

Science

We will be learning about Animals, including humans:
Life cycles and health
identify different stages of the human life cycle
know which offspring come from which parent animal
observe and measure growth in humans..
identify and list the basic needs for survival for humans and animals.
recognise the importance of exercise and personal hygiene.
identify how to have a balanced diet.

Art

We will be learning to:

- use watercolours to paint flowers
- weave paper and plait wool to create our final piece in the style of Alex Katz

We will be learning to :

- explore, design and create our own party food based on a tart



Physical Education

We will be learning to:

- perform 1,2,3 and 4 point balances in gymnastics
- develop sequences and use large apparatus
- move fluently, changing speed and direction
- control a ball when playing football
- defend ourselves when playing football
- aim at a football goal.

Geography

Key question: Why is our world wonderful?

- Identify and locate characteristics of the UK on a map.
- Identify human and physical features.
- Locate human and physical features on a world map.
- Explain the difference between oceans and seas.
- Name and locate the five oceans on a world map

Personal Development

We will be learning about economic wellbeing:

- To understand where money comes from.
- To explore wants and needs.
- To understand the different ways of paying for things including bank account cards.

Music

We will be learning to:

- create a soundscape with dynamic changes.
- compare two pieces of music using musical vocabulary to describe the changes in dynamics.
- show changes in dynamics using bodies and vocals.



Religious Education

Key question: What is a prophet?

- Investigating stories that show the characteristics of a prophet and what a prophet might mean to some people.

Computing

We will be learning to:

- Identify an algorithm and know what debugging is.
- Debug algorithms in real life situations – using written or verbal instructions.
