Year 3 Summer Term Two Overview

This term our focus is Geography. We will be studying Greece and comparing life on the island of Santorini to living in leafy Cheltenham. In Maths, we will be measuring length, capacity and mass. Whilst in English, we focus on the legendary Greek Myths.



Science

We will be learning to:



- notice that magnetic forces can act at a distance
- observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others
- compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet, and identify some magnetic materials
- investigate magnets as having 2 poles

We will also be learning to make Scientific connections through investigations.

Physical Education

We will be learning: Cricket and athletics

- Catch the ball at a variety of heights and speeds
- Throw the ball for distance
- Run a relay with fluent baton changes
- Jump hurdles while running

- We will be making a repeated print based on volcanoes.
- We will use print blocking.



Design and Technology

Topic: Food Technology
Design and make our own bread



Computing

This term we will be using Comic Life to bring a Greek Myth to life:

- Draw pictures or take photos to create a comic.
- Use captions and stickers to add detail.
- Include thought bubbles and narration.



Music

We will be learning about traditional instruments and improvisation.

- Verbalise feelings about music and identify likes and dislikes.
- Play a rag and a tal accurately alongside a drone.
- Sing and play in time with others with some degree of accuracy and awareness of each other's parts.

French

Theme: French transport.

- Recognise transport words in written form.
- Join in with a song using actions to aid recall.
- Generally, speak words with accurate pronunciation.



Personal Development

Theme: relationships

- Recognise the main organs of the body including reproductive organs.
- Types of love
- Personal hygiene (hand washing)

Religious Education

Big question: Why is fire used ceremonially?

We will be learning about different way fire/candles are used, including in Hindu, Jewish and Christian ceremonies. We will consider why Jesus is seen as the 'light of the world' for many Christians.
