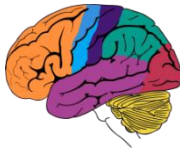
### We will be learning to:

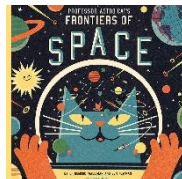

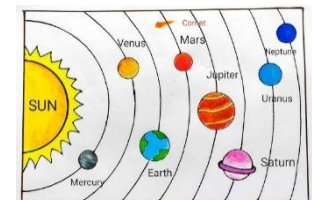

### We will be learning about Earth and Space:

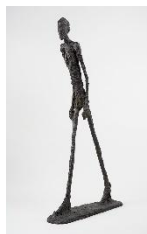
- Exploring Day and Night
