Science

We will be learning to:

We will be investigating how electrical currents work and how the components - that make them up - can change the circuit's output. These are our main objectives:

- associate the brightness of a lamp or the volume of a buzzer with the number and voltage of cells used in the circuit
- compare and give reasons for variations in how components function, including the brightness of bulbs, the loudness of buzzers and the on/off position of switches
- use recognised symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram
