

- I use semi-colons to divide items in a complex list, particularly if commas have already been used.


We will be writing:

Year 6 Summer Term Two Overview

This term, we will be looking at the amazing human body. Looking at the organs that make up the circulatory system and the importance of a healthy balanced lifestyle.

We will be preparing for our end of year showcase as well as creating some amazing pop art inspired by the great Andy Warhol.

Mathematics

Key concepts: Measurement and timetables.

- Use different units of measure to create models in DT.
- Use timetables to navigate locations and know where I need to be and when.
- Create my own timetables to ensure that I am secondary ready and can organise my time.

Science

We will be learning to:

- recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.
- recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents.
- identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

Physical Education

We will be learning to: Rounders and Dance –

- Throw overarm to a designated base
- Begin to make good and effective decisions when fielding
- Dance showing clarity, fluency, accuracy and consistency
- Develop imaginative dances in a specific style



Geography

This term will be looking at Broad Haven vs Cheltenham: A comparison.

- Describe and understand key aspects of: physical geography, including: rivers and the water cycle.
- Use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied.
