School Dinners – Update

We would like to inform parents and carers that, from Monday 5th October, the cost of a school meal will increase to £2.70 per day. This decision has not been taken lightly and it reflects the continued increase in costs linked with providing high-quality meals, including rising food and produce prices, as well as increases to the National Minimum Wage. Despite this increase, we are pleased that our meal price remains lower than a number of other local schools.

If you think your child may now be able to have **Free School Meals under the Government's new eligibility criteria**, we would encourage you to apply as soon as possible.
