## Parking in General

Please can we stress **NOT** to park/drop off children directly outside the school. This includes for Breakfast & Afterschool Club.

**It is DANGEROUS!**

**Seasons Car Park is only 2/3 mins walk away and has lots of spaces.**

Parking at/very close to the junction of Quat Goose Lane and Church Road is not only **illegal** but again is very **DANGEROUS**.

*The Highways code Rule 243 states you cannot park opposite or within 10 meters of a junction, there needs to be clear passage for vehicles and pedestrians.*
