As I'm sure you're aware, our main topic focus for this term is history. The children have had a fascinating time so far learning about people and significant events from the past.

As part of our celebration of learning we will be holding a **Whole School History Day** on **Tuesday 24th October**. We are asking that every child dresses in clothing that reflects the time period that they have studied. Here is a list of the time periods studied:

From 2pm onwards, relatives will be invited into the school to come and see our Living History Museum. Below are some simple ideas for how to dress your child in suitable clothing for the day.
