Following the success of some of our very own Swindon Village writers, we would like to announce our very first

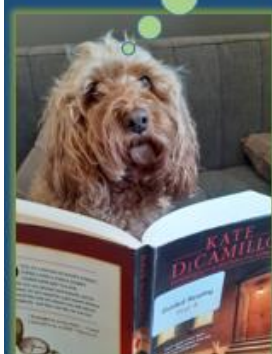
