8:45am Classroom Doors Opening - September

Like all schools we are having to think creatively about how to manage our budget in these difficult times. We have been thinking carefully about how to reduce some of our costs without causing a negative effect on your children's education. Historically children come into classrooms from 8:35am, however from September we are having to make the change to 8:45am (classroom doors opening). This slight change means that we are able to provide more 'full-day' support to each year group and also cover other key times of the days.

From September:

- Red Gates opened from around 8:40am (members of staff will be on the gate as usual, there will also be a member of staff on the back playground)
- Classroom Doors open from 8:45am (bell will signal this)
- Parents will be required to stay on the playground until their child(ren) are in their classrooms.
- Older children (Y5/Y6) will be able to continue to bring their younger children to school, however you will need to remind them to stay with their younger brother or sister until they go into class.
- The start and end of the school day will remain as per the Government minimum hours – 8:50am – 3:20pm
