Over the course of the year, children will train in musical theatre and work together to create a full-scale production, which we will perform at the Parabola Arts Centre June 2026. The club will run every week, starting the week commencing 8th September 2025, immediately after school. The cost is £60 per full term, and it is a year-long commitment.
