

Dear Parents

Swimming – September/October

I am writing to let you know that Years 4, 5 and 6 will taking part in swimming lessons later this half term.

Due to rising costs and logistics, we are excited to let you know that we will be having an enclosed heated swimming pool set up in the **MUGA at Swindon Village Primary School** for 2 weeks, along with a qualified instructor, who will be teaching the children in groups of no more than 10.

Where will the children get changed?

- Sectioned changing tents will be set up in the Studio.

How much will swimming lessons cost?

- £20 – for 5 sessions of swimming
- Please note that whilst this is a National Curriculum requirement, swimming is a huge cost and strain on our ever-depleting school budget. We are very fortunate that this year our fabulous FOSVPS still have enough funds to help towards swimming in Key Stage.

When will swimming take place?

- The swimming pool will be in school from Monday 28th September to Friday 9th October. We will let you know nearer the time which days your child has been allocated.

How can I pay?

Payment can be made **by Friday 2nd October 2026:**

- our Online Payments Facility – this is our preferred method
- cash or cheque payable to Swindon Village Primary School (SVPS).

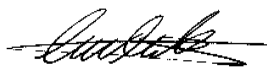
What will my child need to bring on their swimming day?

- Swimming costume (no bikini's please)
- Towel or Robe to walk from the school to the pool
- Flip flops / Crocs / sliders
- Goggles – optional but they really do help
- No jewellery to be worn in the pool
- Bag for wet swimming kit

Please put your child's name clearly on ALL items of clothing/towel/goggles...etc.

As this is a National Curriculum requirement there is no option to opt out at this stage.
