Funded by Heidi's Heroes and delivered by Move More, CLC, Cheltenham College and Dean Close; Swim Cheltenham Intervention is a fantastic swimming programme put in place to help schools and their pupils meet the required 25m National Curriculum Level of Swimming by the time they finish primary school.

This is an annual programme aimed at **year 5 & year 6 pupils** who would benefit from an intensive swimming course, run every day over the course of a week. The aim of the course is to improve their confidence around water, swimming travel ability and overall safety in and around water. This programme has proven results in helping all children, even those who are complete non swimmer and extremely nervous and reluctant around water.

We believe that your child would greatly benefit from this swimming course intervention. Please can you confirm that you are happy for your child to participate in this programme by completing and returning the slip below to the school office before the **6th June 2025**.

All children taking part in the day will be accompanied by school staff and transported from the school to **Cheltenham College Swimming Pool** where they will take part in a 30-minute swim session every day of the week. After the swimming session they will be collected from the swimming pool and transported back to school.

Children are required to bring the following to school every day in a named plastic / waterproof bag:

- Dry swimwear
- Dry towel
- Swimming goggles (if owned)
- Poolside shoes or sliders (if owned)
